What is a cicada?

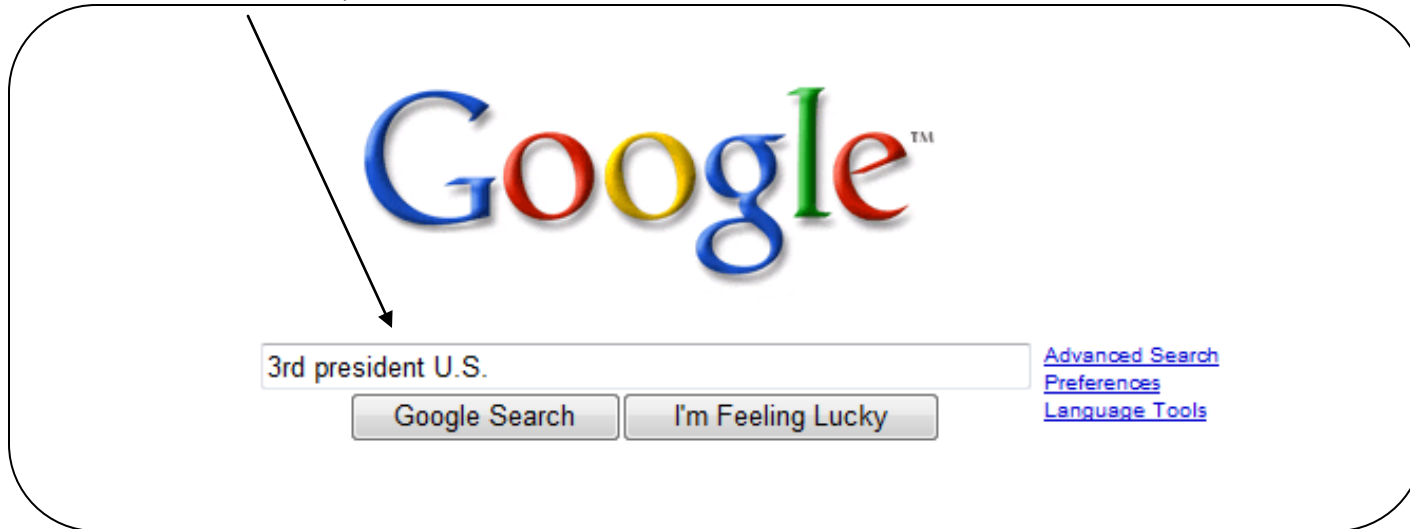
Internet Scavenger Hunt

1. Go to www.google.com
2. Type the keywords into the Search bar.

For example:

Who was the third president of the U. S.?

These are the keywords:



3. Look at the list of websites. Can you see the answer? If not, can you tell which website may have the answer?
4. Click on the link to the website that looks good.

5. To return to the list of web sites, use the Back button.
6. Use the Internet Scavenger Hunt Chart on page 162 to write down your answers.
