The White House

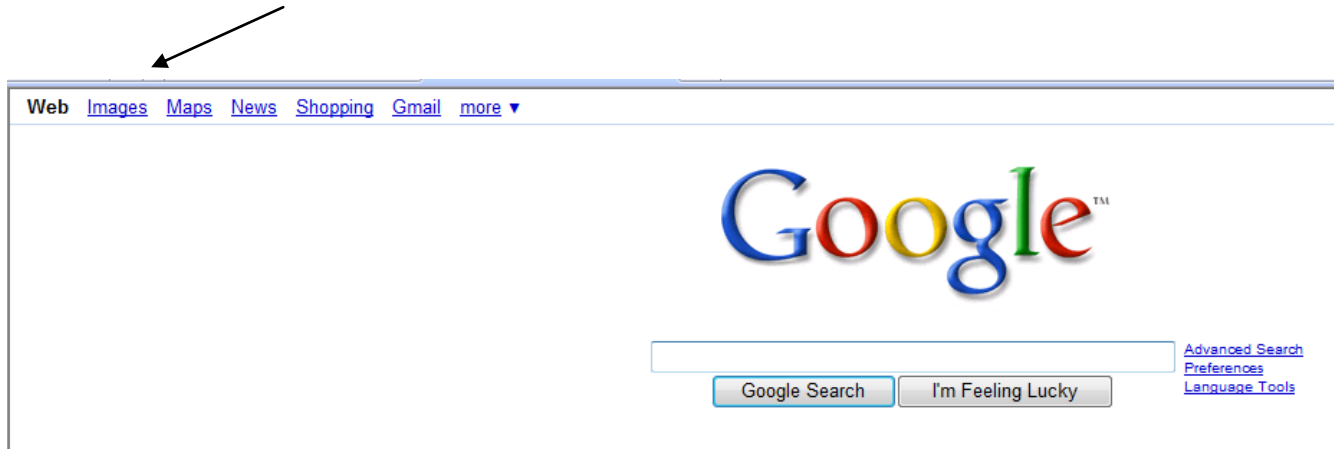

1. Go to www.google.com

2. Click on [Images](#) at the top of the page.



3. Type in your keywords and hit **Search Images**.

4. Click on a picture to make it bigger.

Picture Scavenger Hunt

Now you can copy the picture. Use your mouse to highlight the picture. It will turn blue when you have it highlighted.

To copy and paste:

Hit Ctrl + C.
Minimize the screen.
Open Microsoft Word.
Hit Ctrl + V.



Another way to copy and paste is to use your mouse. Highlight the picture. Right-click. Scroll down and click on Copy. Open your Word document. Right-click. Scroll down and click Paste.
